

Aged 28, Darwin Private Life

Darwin - aged 28 - began thinking about settling down and he married his cousin (Emma Wedgwood) on the twenty ninth January 1836. They had three children who were: William, Anne Elizabeth and Horace. In 1842, they moved to Downe, Kent with a big house, a nice garden to walk in and they kept pigeons.

Legacy

Charles Darwin got sick when he was older, perhaps ^{he was} bitter by a nasty bug during his travels - no one knows for sure. Darwin died on the nineteenth of April 1882, aged 72 and buried in Westminster Abbey - ^{the} _a privilege of important people. People came from around the world to attend his funeral. Charles Darwin's face is on today's £10 notes and has a statue of him in London's ^{Natural} History Museum. As well as all this, more than 120 species of animals are named after him.
