

## Maths

The children will be looking at a variety of key mathematical skills including number and place value, We will be looking at multiplication and division and counting in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000. We will also be measuring and calculating the length and perimeter of shapes in centimetres and metres.



## English

The children will have the opportunity to develop their skills in writing including the writing of instruction texts and recounts. We will also be exploring traditional and ancient tales such as Beowulf. We will also be using other myths and legends to extend our writing.

## Science

We will start off looking at the difference between solids liquids and gases. We will examine the reasons for a change in state and find examples in nature. We will then move on to studying the human digestive system including looking at different types of teeth and dental hygiene.

## History and Geography

We will be looking at what happened to Britain after the departure of the Romans. We will find out who the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings were, what they wore, where they lived and why they decided to come to Britain. We will also explore their cultures, examining storytelling and religious beliefs in particular. We will use maps to help us study different types of settlements, learn why people first settled in particular places.

## P.E.

On Monday afternoons P.E lessons will be Basketball. On Friday mornings, P.E. lessons will be gymnastics. The children will build on their gymnastics teaching from last year as well as developing greater ball control and learning how to play basketball.
