•Let parents/carers know about any concerns or problems that affect a child's work or well-being or behaviour

•Provide regular assessments and an annual written report for each pupil •Arrange parent/carer Consultation evenings at which each pupil's progress will be discussed

•Support parents and carers to improve their knowledge of school life through parent workshops and information

•See that their child arrives at school properly equipped and on time, and provide notice and explanation of any absence

•Speak to the class teacher or a senior member of staff if there are any concerns so that issues may be addressed without delay

•Read communications from school and respond promptly where necessary •Support the school's policies and guidelines for children's behaviour •Support their child with homework and encourage other opportunities for

learning at home •Treat all members of staff and the school community with respect

•Attend Parent/Carer Consultation evenings to discuss their child's progress •Support the school's ethos towards parental engagement and contribute, where possible
