Safeguarding: Attendance

Monitoring the attendance of our pupils is an important part of our statutory safeguarding responsibilities. We thought it would be useful to provide parents/carers with an overview of responsibilities around attendance:

What Parents/Carers must do:

- Telephone or email the school before 8.50am **each day** of your child's absence. Please leave an answer phone message if the phone is busy.
- Try to book any routine medical, dental etc. appointments outside of school hours.
- Tell the school in advance, of any appointments which cannot take place outside of school hours – complete and send in a Leave of Absence form: https://manland.herts.sch.uk/parents/forms/
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, check NHS guidance: https://www.nhs.uk/live-well/is-my-child-too-ill-for-school/
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help.

What school will do:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Update you if your child's attendance falls below 96%.
- Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.
- If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.




As always, we recognise the current financial challenges that many of our families are facing and we do not want anyone to feel obliged to purchase a gift.

Spotlight on fundraising


