We are so incredibly fortunate to have such a supportive parent/carer community at Manland and our Home School Association (HSA) are very much part of our Manland family.



Financial Support - Childcare Choices

In October, HM Government updated their eligibility checker on <u>childcarechoices.gov.uk</u>, enabling parents to access personalised information on the support available to them, including which of the new childcare offers they will be eligible for depending on the age of * their child and earnings.

An additional feature added to the website is a subscribe for updates function, which will give parents the opportunity to sign up for regular newsletters letting them know when they should take action to make sure they are getting the support they are entitled to – including information about wraparound for primary school children and when the new 15 hours for two-year-olds becomes available for sign-ups, with the offer beginning in April 2024.
