Children coming to the fete will need a pre-sold games card, which can still be purchased. The form is attached to this newsletter. Siblings and family friends are welcome to pre-purchase cards as well. Please complete the form and return it, as soon as possible, with your payment to the school office. Please mark your envelope 'HSA Summer Fete'.

Included in the £5 cost are all the following activities - water gun area, nature trail / letter hunt in wildlife area (under 7s to accompanied by an adult), playground chalk area, craft table, pin the hat on the Head, balloon shy, hook a duck, sweetie tombola, adopt a teddy, beat the goalie, throwing game, pick a lolly, lucky dip. After collecting ten stamps from the activities, your child will win a prize, which will be available for collection after 5pm.

And that's not all. Additional stalls, although not included with the games card, are Glazetime pottery painting, face painting and a mad science show as well as food and refreshments including cup cakes & cookies, ice creams, hungry hog BBQ and Governors' Pimms. There will be a bottle tombola, plants for sale and a Lego card swap table with donations going to the Grenfell Tower fund.
