Dear Parents and Carers,

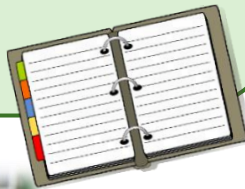

Secondary school transition

Step2Skills is offering two courses this June for parents of primary school leavers, to help understand the transition to secondary school level maths and English.

- **Getting Ready for English at secondary school - A 5-week, online, live-streamed course starting on Tuesday 7th June at 1pm to 3pm.**

Both courses will cover the various topics within the curriculum and the strategies and methods used to teach your child. You'll discover activities each week that you can use to help build your child's confidence as they make the transition to secondary level education.
