

Communication and Language

We will be developing children's ability to listen 1:1 and in small groups to follow instructions. How and Why questions will be focused on for their understanding and ability to explain. Talking in the present tense and using tenses to retell stories and using talk to pretend objects are something else using vocabulary from their own experiences.

Phonics

In phonics we will be focusing on the children hearing and saying initial and final sounds. We will look at phase 1 and 2 of letters and sounds through lots of interactive games and activities. The children will learn how to segment and blend words using their phonics.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our main topic is being me in my world, understanding how we are the same and different, we will be identifying and managing feelings. The children will be encourage to develop relationships and independence. We will also learn that behaviour has consequences and we are responsible for us.

Physical Development

We will be developing confidence to move in a range of ways, and observing the effect of activity on our bodies. PD also moves into the children's ability to form recognisable letters, show a dominant hand for writing and holding a pencil between thumb and two fingers. We will also be developing their ability to dress themselves or with a small amount of help so if this is something that could be practiced at home.

Learning Journals

Learning journals in reception are used to document and celebrate the children's ongoing learning in relation to the surrounded topics. These journals are individual to the child and you are welcome to contribute to them with WOW moments from home.

Literacy

One of the first things we will cover is writing their own name and developing their mark making skills so they're able to give meaning to marks and label a picture. The children will also begin to enjoy stories, poems and rhymes

Maths

We will be exploring early number recognition and counting to 10 this term as well as ordering and recognising patterns. We will also begin to explore counting objects and associating physical with mental.

Understanding the World

We will be encouraging children to talk about their environment and show care and concern for the environment around them. We will be making observations of plants and animals. We will also be looking at how to show interest in the lives of the people around us.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring colour and how it can be changed. We will be using movement to express feelings in response to music and singing songs to encourage them to make up their own. The child should also be engaging in role play based on their own experiences.
