

## **Communication and Language**

We will keep developing the children's communication and language skills through modelling conversations and different questions.

We will be exploring expressing our ideas and feelings about our own experiences and understanding, using full sentences and varying tenses.

## **Phonics**

In phonics, the children will be focusing on developing their ability to segment and blend words using their already taught phonics. We will look at phase 4 of Letters and Sounds through lots of interactive games and activities. The children will continue to practise initial, middle and final sounds, as well as, learning tricky words.

## **Physical Development**

We will be ensuring we have a secure tripod pencil grip this term and working on our pencil pressure. We will also be having lots of opportunities to move energetically, jump, dance, hop, skip and climb to develop our gross motor skills.

## **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

We will be continuing to understand and regulate our emotions, building a repertoire of techniques to help manage emotion. We will be focusing on how to keep healthy through the learning and understanding of healthy food choices. We will also be practising following rules in relation to behaviour and understanding right and wrong choices.

## **Learning Journals**

Learning journals in Reception are used to document and celebrate the children's ongoing learning in relation to our topics. These journals are individual to the child and you are welcome to contribute to them with WOW moments from home.

## **Literacy**

We will be continuing to write simple sentences and phrases that can be read by others whilst forming recognisable letters. We will continue reading aloud simple sentences using our phonics and known common exception words.

## **Maths**

We will be exploring number bonds up to 5 and 10 this term teaching the children to automatically recall the facts. We will also be looking at number patterns including even and odd numbers, doubling facts and sharing quantities equally. We will also be perfecting our subitising to 5 (recognising quantities without counting).

## **Understanding the World**

We will be focusing on the natural world, exploring our environment and making observations and drawing of animals and plants around us. We will be learning and understanding some processes and changes in the natural world. We will be exploring different countries focusing on the similarities and differences between them and England.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

We will be developing our ability to share our creations this term explaining processes we have used and why. We will continue to explore the performance of song, rhymes and plays as well as inventing our own narratives and stories.
