Routines

- * Beginning of the day -The children come in on their own through the Year 1 and 2 door, put their belongings on their peg and go into the classroom.
- * Water bottles – Everyone needs to bring a named water bottle each day. Children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day.
- * Snack - Fruit or vegetables are provided for the children everyday. You can provide a fruit snack in their bag.
- * Lunch - Please discuss with your child what they would like to eat before school. The lunch menu is attached to the classroom window if needed.
- * End of the day – The children will be lined up on the playground. Please wait for us to send them to you. Please email or call the school office to let them know if your child is going home with someone different.

School Uniform

- * Please make sure that all your child's clothes and belongings are named.
- * We would appreciate your support in ensuring the children wear their correct school uniform. If you are unsure, the school website has information about what children should wear to school.
- * No jewellery of any kind should be worn, except small stud earrings and a watch. (No smart watches please!)
- * Children should wear suitable school shoes at all times – no trainers, except for PE lessons.

P.E.

- * The children will have P.E lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- * Please leave P.E kits in school for half a term. We will send them home earlier if they get dirty!
- * P.E Kit – Black shorts, red t-shirt, pumps or trainers.
- * Outdoor P.E Kit – dark tracksuit bottoms and warm top for winter sports.

Curriculum

- Phonics – The children will have a daily phonics lesson.
- There will be a phonics screening in the summer term.
- There will be a phonics workshop on Friday 27th September for Year 1 parents.
- English - Labels, captions and lists, stories with predictable phrasing, recount, poetry, instructions.
- Maths – Place value within 10 including counting and comparing numbers to ten, addition and subtraction within 10 and identifying and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

Curriculum

- In History they will be looking at old and new toys.
- In Geography the children will learn about our town.
- In Science, they will be naming body parts and looking at senses. We will then look at materials. We will also begin learning about the 4 seasons.
- In Art the children will start with an artist study on the artist, Yayoi Kusama.
- In computing the children will be introduced to the idea of algorithms with programmable toys.

Reading

- Every week your child will come home with
 - 1 Little Wandle reading book
 - 2 sharing books
- They will be allocated a changing book day but please bring the reading folder to school each day.
- The children will go out of the class for a reading group 3 times per week.
- Individual reading – at other times with teacher/TA or parent volunteer.
- Please try to read with your child a little bit each day. This could be from the reading book, sharing books, a book from home or the library.
- We would be grateful if you would sign their reading record after they have read the school books.

Homework

- Homework will be sent home on a Friday and needs to be brought back into school by Wednesday.
- English – CGP grammar, punctuation and spelling.
- Maths – White Rose workbook.
- Spellings – based on the phonics we have covered during the week, including tricky words.
- Additional homework activities – these are there if you want to something extra.

Bits and Bobs

- Library will be on a Friday. Please send their library books in their bags on Fridays if they want to change it.
- Money - please send into school in a labelled bag or envelope or pay on school gateway.
- Show and tell - we don't have an allocated slot for this but they can bring things in to school occasionally to show the class. Please no toys.
- Trips - We will have trips in term 2 and 3. In term 1 we are hoping to have a history workshop in school.
