# Topics covered in Year 2



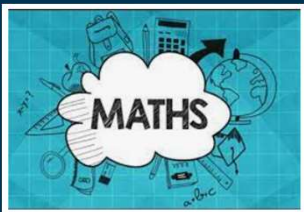
