We are pleased to be able to release our club offering for the spring 2024 term. If you would like your child to take part in one of the clubs below, please email clubbookings@manland.herts.sch.uk by **Wednesday 20th December 2023**.

Please note that after-school sports clubs will take place outside so please ensure that your child has weather appropriate clothes and footwear. Children who do not have the appropriate kit in school on club day will spectate for the week.

Please look carefully at the start and end dates of each club and keep a note of these in your home diaries.

Payment for school led clubs will be via the school gateway once your child's space has been confirmed. We do not issue emails confirming club spots; if your child has a spot in the club it will appear as a payment item in your school gateway account.

All club payments are due by the end of the first week of term, Friday 12th January 2024.

For external clubs, please book and pay with the provider (contact details attached).

Lunchtime clubs **do not** need to be booked and are free; any child can take part on the day. If your child wishes to attend a lunchtime club, they need to have:

- a PE kit in school (plus shin guards/pads for football clubs)
- a packed lunch or order the sandwich option from the school kitchen.

Unfortunately your child will not be able to take part that week if they do not have the appropriate kit and lunch.

We appreciate that the cost of living is having an impact on everyone at the moment and we are keen that no child should miss out on a club due to financial reasons.
